

ABORIGINAL & EUROPEAN CULTURAL HERITAGE



Management Targets are listed in the order of priority from the Feb 2007 workshop

MTCH3: By 2016, 100% of completed integrated property management plans will address the management issues relating to cultural heritage resources and other culturally significant areas, both Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal

- 👉 Develop a cultural heritage module for property planning framework to ensure identification and protection of culturally significant areas

MTCH1: By 2016, protection of culturally significant aspects of the landscape, both Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal

- 💰 All Management Actions to incorporate Aboriginal perspectives and traditional land management techniques where appropriate
- 👉 Identify and produce a resource that shows areas/ landscapes and objects of Non Aboriginal Cultural heritage which overlaps Aboriginal Cultural Heritage
- 👉 Work with communities on reclamation of traditional practices - Aboriginal and Non Aboriginal
- 👉 Establish a forum to enable CMA, government agencies, NGOs and others involved in cultural heritage management to share best practice knowledge. Use forum outcomes for actions in the CMA and for training CMA staff members
- 😊 Establish and implement a Cultural Heritage Incentive Program including on ground works and capacity building

MTCH2: By 2016, increase negotiated indigenous access to lands within the catchment which are of Aboriginal cultural significance, but which recognise the legitimate rights of landholders

- 💰 Develop intellectual property **framework** for traditional knowledge
- 💰 Research and publicise best practice/models of negotiated access for private landholders to cultural sites within the catchment and support maintenance of the sites
- 👉 Training of Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal community on issues related to agreements (negotiation skills, etc.)
- 😊 Cultural heritage Training for Aboriginal people
