Management Targets are listed in the order of priority from the Feb 2007 workshop

**MTPC2: By 2016, increase in the participation of land managers involved in regional planning process and the practical application of Natural Resource Management (NRM) strategies**

- \$ Continue Local government partnership/grants program and support to Local Govt Reference Group
- \$ Landcare Reference Group supported to ensure involvement in Natural Resource Management (NRM) decision making and projects
- \$ Continue to deliver relevant field days, training opportunities and workshops for best practice NRM
- 👉 Develop partnership program with community and industry groups such as CDEP, employment agencies and Agricultural industries
- 👉 Utilise the skills of landholders who are using Property Management Plan (PMP) to manage their properties as 'champions' in the Central West catchment
- 😊 Build community capacity to adapt to the effects and impacts of climate change on NRM

**MTPC4: By 2016, increase in the number of Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal people involved in indigenous NRM projects**

- \$ The Aboriginal Reference Group (ARG) supported to ensure involvement in NRM decision making and projects
- \$ Develop educational program to engage aboriginal youth in all NRM with priority for high school level traineeships as recommended by ARG, and provide cadetships where ever possible
- \$ High level regional conference/summit. This forum should also be offered twice a year
- 👉 Include experimental learning and training techniques to increase the number of Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal people involved in indigenous NRM projects
- 👉 ARG members could attend and participate in CMA exhibits/displays etc.
- 👉 NRM education programs to include consideration of traditional cultural practices
- 👉 Develop Aboriginal employment strategy for NRM management targets
- 👉 Training for the Aboriginal community in Natural Resource Management in general
- 😊 Invest in local communities through our local Aboriginal Reference Group (ARG) members to highlight and support opportunities for NRM indigenous enterprise development and employment opportunities
- 😊 Facilitate interaction between CMA reference groups including an annual conference covering aboriginal Nations Groups. This process could include other ARG's from elsewhere
- 😊 Assist ARG members to attend national indigenous forums

**MTPC1: By 2016, have in place NRM education programs for schools, community and land managers**

- \$ Natural resource management education activities for all CAP Themes conducted in the community and schools
- \$ Community water quality program through Waterwatch and BRS
- \$ Community monitoring of all Natural Resource Management Themes in CAP
- 👉 Investigate options for input in to environmental education policy to enhance existing environmental education
- 😊 Small Community Grants up to \$2000 handled by each CMA office to engage community in NRM
- 😊 Increase water use education and awareness across the catchment
- 😊 Support provenance plant/seed bank programs within the Central West Catchment

**MTPC3: By 2016, implement three programs to increase knowledge and understanding of the wider community of Aboriginal culture and cultural projects**

- \$ Implement a cultural awareness training program for the wider community
